Notice Regarding the Geographic CoPs

On January 30, 2009, the naming convention for the geographic communities changed. The term "geographic" was dropped from in front of the name of the state. So now Geographic: Nebraska will become Nebraska Community. You will be able to more easily search and find a community for a component state association in the Join/Visit Communities. If you currently belong to a geographic community, you will now find it on your Personal Page under My Communities by the state name such as N for Nebraska instead of G for Geographic: Nebraska. This will not affect the great content you receive within the community. This change is based on the recommendation of the CoP focus groups conducted in 2007, the CSA Advisory Task Force, and the CoP Advisory Task Force.

ICD-10 Final Rule is Out

After years of rumor and speculation on whether or not ICD-10 would ever be implemented, the answer is finally here. On January 15th, 2009 the Department of Health and Human Services published the final rule to adopt ICD-10 as the new national coding standard. ICD-10 will take effect on October 1, 2013.
